Ask the Holy Spirit to guide us as we read Philippians 2:1-11:

- What do you see as the most powerful point of this passage?
- According to verses 3-4, what should motivate our actions in relationships with others?
- Describe the "mindset" of Jesus. What part of that challenges you?
- Name someone who has demonstrated what it looks like to honor and serve others.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to bring someone to mind. What step can you take to:
 - Serve them?
 - Honor them?
 - Sacrifice for them?
- Write down "I will" statements of the action steps we feel prompted to take so we can follow up next week!

Out: Who is someone you'd like to invite to this group? Let's spend time praying for those names.
